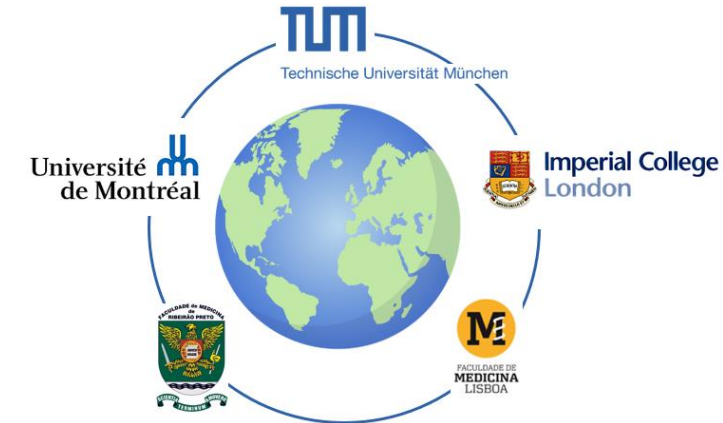

## Concept

The **International Dementia School** brings together students and early-career professionals of different disciplines (medicine, psychology, nursing, social work, occupational therapy, speech and language therapy, physical therapy) from four countries: Brazil, Canada, Germany, Portugal and the United Kingdom. It combines cutting-edge research news with a real-life perspective on dementia care and interactive exercises.

The **goal** of the International Dementia School is to provide a shared bio-psycho-social concept of dementia, a person-centred understanding of and dementia care and promote interprofessional cooperation.

The event will involve **top-grade dementia experts** who will present latest basic and clinical research as well as **professionals** who will outline the practice of dementia care. Participants will learn about dementia in a compact yet comprehensive, scientifically up-to date and interactive course program.

## Structure

The **International Dementia School** will be hosted as a virtual event using Zoom and will be held from May 2 to 6, 2022 from 2 pm to 8 pm Munich time (São Paulo: 10 am to 4 pm, Montréal: 8 am to 2 pm, Lisbon and London: 1 pm to 7 pm)

Five **keynote lectures** will give a scientific update on dementia research and care. Topics will include introduction to neuropsychiatry, novel pharmacological treatments, new technologies in cognitive rehabilitation, early diagnosis, and the concept of brain reserve.

Five **professional profiles** will provide a real-life perspective on dementia care, highlighting the contributions of several occupations with a focus on the quality of life of

people with dementia and family carers. Local professionals will be interviewed about their work.

To make the International Dementia School engaging and enjoyable, exercises, role plays, quizzes, virtual excursions and homework will be included. Participants will be actively involved and will have tasks to perform.
